Installation and setup guide for PrestaShop 8.0.0 or later

Product page, listings and search

3 stock states

Cut-off time and holidays

Editable colours and texts

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Shows the customer an estimated delivery date —“Recíbelo el ...”— on the product page, in listings and in search results. The date is counted in working days from your order cut-off time, skipping Saturdays, Sundays and the holidays you enter, and it changes depending on whether the product is in stock, can be ordered out of stock, or is sold out.

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1 What the module does

Estimated delivery date

A “Recíbelo el ...” block with a single date or a date range.

3 stock states

In stock, out of stock but orderable, and sold out.

Working days

Order cut-off time; skips Saturdays, Sundays and your holidays.

Editable look

Texts, icons, colours, borders, padding and font size.

The settings screen is in Spanish

The module's configuration panel only exists in Spanish. This guide quotes each label exactly as it appears, followed by its meaning in English.

2 Before you start

- PrestaShop 8.0.0 or later.
- Your theme must render the `displayProductAdditionalInfo` (product page) and `displayProductPriceBlock` (listings) hooks; the exact position of the block depends on the theme.
- Check your store's time zone: the cut-off time is compared with the PHP server time.

3 Installation

- 1 Back office → **Modules** → **Module Manager** → **Upload a module**.
- 2 Select the `zeyvro_deliverydate` ZIP and wait for it to finish.
- 3 Find **Zeyvro Delivery Date** in the Module Manager and click **Configure**.

Works straight away

On install the module already has default values (cut-off 16, 1-2 days in stock, 3-5 days out of stock) and is visible on the product page, listings and search. No activation key is required.

All settings are on one screen and are saved with **Guardar configuración** (Save settings).

4 Where to show the delivery block

Section **Dónde mostrar el bloque de entrega** (Where to show the delivery block).

FIELD	WHAT IT DOES
Ficha de producto (<i>product page</i>)	Shows the block on the product page (<code>displayProductAdditionalInfo</code> hook; the panel describes it as “below the add to cart button”).
Listados y categorías (<i>listings and categories</i>)	Shows it on product cards, after the price (<code>displayProductPriceBlock</code> hook).
Resultados de búsqueda (<i>search results</i>)	Shows it on the search results page. Also requires Listados y categorías to be on.

5 Behaviour and date calculation

Section **Comportamiento y cálculo de fechas** (Behaviour and date calculation).

FIELD	WHAT IT DOES
Hora límite de pedido (formato 24h) (<i>order cut-off time, 24h</i>)	0 to 23. From that hour on the dot, counting starts from the next day. E.g. 16 = until 16:00.
Festivos (YYYY-MM-DD, uno por línea) (<i>holidays, one per line</i>)	Dates that do not count as working days, e.g. <code>2026-12-25</code> . Commas are also accepted as separators; lines in any other format are ignored.

How it is calculated: take today (or tomorrow, if the cut-off has passed); if that day is a Saturday, Sunday or holiday, move to the next working day; from there add the state's minimum and maximum working days. Examples with cut-off 16 and 1-2 days:

ORDER	DATE SHOWN (NO HOLIDAYS)
Monday at 10:00	Tuesday – Wednesday

Monday at 17:00	Wednesday – Thursday
Friday at 10:00	Monday – Tuesday
Friday at 17:00, Saturday or Sunday	Tuesday – Wednesday

6 General block design

Section **Diseño general del bloque** (General block design).

Tamaño de fuente (rem) (<i>font size</i>)	Text size of the block.	0.92
Radio de bordes (px) (<i>border radius</i>)	Corner rounding (0–50).	6
Grosor del borde (px) (<i>border width</i>)	Border width (0–10).	1
Padding vertical (px) · Padding horizontal (px)	Inner spacing (0–40 · 0–60).	10 · 14
Mostrar icono/emoji (<i>show icon/emoji</i>)	Shows the icon before the text.	On
Fecha en negrita (<i>bold date</i>)	Highlights the delivery date.	On

7 Settings per stock state

Section **Configuración por estado de stock**. The module assigns each product one of three states, each with its own card:

CARD IN THE PANEL	WHEN IT APPLIES	DEFAULT TEXT AND ICON	DAYS
Entrega rápida (en stock) (<i>fast, in stock</i>)	Available for order and quantity above 0.	📦 Recíbelo el	1–2
Entrega normal (bajo stock) (<i>normal</i>)	Quantity 0 or less, but the product allows out-of-stock orders.	🕒 Recíbelo entre el	3–5
Agotado / Sin stock (<i>sold out</i>)	Not available for order, or out of stock without allowing orders.	🚫 Agotado - Consultar disponibilidad	—

Fields on each card:

FIELD	WHAT IT DOES
Icono/Emoji (<i>icon/emoji</i>)	Icon shown before the text.
Texto prefijo (<i>prefix text</i>)	Text before the date (in stock and normal).
Texto (mensaje completo) (<i>full message</i>)	Single message for the sold-out state; no date.
Días mín. · Días máx. (<i>min · max days</i>)	Working days of the range (0–30 in stock, 0–60 normal). If min and max give the same date, only one date is shown.
Color de fondo · Color de borde · Color de texto (<i>background · border · text colour</i>)	Colour picker or hex code.
Texto en negrita (<i>bold text</i>)	Makes the whole block text bold.

Below, **Vista previa (con la configuración guardada)** (preview with saved settings) shows the three blocks with the values already saved: save to see your changes.

8 What the customer sees

A block with the icon, the text and the date, for example 📦 **Recíbelo el martes 3 de marzo – miércoles 4 de marzo**, or the sold-out message. The date is always written in Spanish, as weekday, day number and month.

9 Frequently asked questions

I cannot see the block on the product page or in listings.

Check the switches under **Dónde mostrar el bloque de entrega** and that your theme includes the `displayProductAdditionalInfo` and `displayProductPriceBlock` hooks. If the theme does not call them, the block does not appear.

Does it take the carrier or the customer's zone into account?

No. The days for each state are the same for every order.

Can I show the date in another language?

Texts, icons and colours are editable, but they are a single value for all languages, and day and month names are always generated in Spanish.

Can I adjust the style from my theme?

Yes. The block uses the classes `dd-wrapper`, `dd--fast` / `dd--slow` / `dd--out`, `dd-icon`, `dd-label` and `dd-date`. Colours, borders and padding from the panel are applied as inline style.

Are the settings deleted on uninstall?

No: uninstalling does not remove the saved settings.
