Every redirect in your store, managed from the back office: the ones you create and the ones the module detects by itself when the URL of a product or a category changes. No editing `.htaccess`, no redirect chains and no 404s left behind after every catalog change.

Version 1.7.2 · Compatible with PrestaShop 8.0.0 - 9.x · PHP 8.x
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1 What the module does

It manages every redirect in your store from the back office, without editing `.htaccess` and without losing them when PrestaShop regenerates that file.

Manual redirects

301 permanent, 302 temporary and 303, with list, filters and editing.

Slug suggestions

When you rename a product it proposes the new URL and applies it together with the 301 in one click.

Slug auto-detection

If the `link_rewrite` of a product or a category changes, the 301 is created automatically.

Product removals

Lists retired products whose URL is still live and redirects them in bulk.

Chains resolved

With A→B and B→C, when C changes to D the module updates A→D. No chained hops.

History and CSV

Log of automatic changes, plus bulk import and export.

2 Installation

- 1 Back office → **Modules** → **Module Manager** → **Upload a module**.
- 2 Select `zeyvroseoredirect-1.7.2.zip` and wait for it to finish.
- 3 Open the **Zeyvro** → **SEO Redirects** menu, which the module adds on install.

No key to enter

The module ships without DRM: it works as soon as it is installed, asks for no activation key and never contacts a validation server. This is independent of the license terms that cover your purchase, described in section 10.

3 Redirects screen

Menu **Zeyvro** → **SEO Redirects**. One row per rule, with filters and sorting on every column.

COLUMN	WHAT IT CONTAINS
ID	Internal identifier of the rule.
Old URL (path)	Source path. It always starts with <code>/</code> . E.g. <code>/old-shaving-soap.html</code>
New URL	Full destination, with <code>http://</code> or <code>https://</code> .
Type	301 permanent · 302 temporary · 303.
Source	<i>manual</i> if you created it, <i>auto</i> if the module generated it when a slug changed.
Date	Creation date.

Create a redirect

- 1 Click **New redirect**.
- 2 **Old URL**: the old path, starting with `/`.
- 3 **New URL**: the full destination URL, with protocol.
- 4 Choose the type (301 by default) and save. Confirmation: *Redirect saved successfully*.

Delete

Tick several rows and use **Delete selected**, or delete one from its own row.

Delete all

Removes ALL redirects of the active store. It asks you to tick a confirmation box and cannot be undone: export the CSV first.

4 CSV import and export

Import

- **Import CSV** button: choose the file and the separator, `;` (recommended) or `,`.
- Format per line: `old_url;new_url;type`

- Example: `/old-page.html;https://yourstore.com/new-page.html;301`
- When it finishes it tells you how many were imported and how many were discarded as duplicated or malformed.

Export

Export CSV button: downloads every redirect of the active store. The number next to the button is the total number of rows.

5 Slug suggestions

Suggestions tab, with the number of pending ones in brackets. They appear when you change a product's name but its URL still carries the old text.

COLUMN	WHAT IT SHOWS
Product	Affected product.
New title	New product name.
Old URL	URL it has right now.
Suggested new URL	URL proposed by the module.

- **Apply** — changes the product slug and creates the 301 from the old URL to the new one, in a single step.
- **Dismiss** — discards the suggestion and leaves the product as it is.

6 Product removals

Product removals tab: products that are disabled or deny orders whose URL is still live and has no redirect. It avoids leaving 404s behind when you retire references.

- Filters by status (all · disabled · deny orders) and by manufacturer.
- Per row: choose the destination — category, manufacturer or product by ID — and click **Create**.
- In bulk: tick several rows, choose destination and type (301 or 302) and click **Apply to selected**.
- A product leaves the list as soon as a redirect exists for its current URL.

7 Settings

Settings tab. A single option, **Trailing slash**:

OPTION	BEHAVIOUR	WHEN TO USE IT
Strict (default)	The request only matches the rule saved with the exact URL: <code>/page</code> and <code>/page/</code> are different rules.	Store with consistent URLs; maximum control.
Either	The same rule serves the URL with and without the trailing slash.	Migrations from another platform with both forms linked.

Save with the panel button; it confirms with *Settings saved*.

8 How it works under the hood

The module hooks into seven PrestaShop hooks:

HOOK	ROLE
<code>actionDispatcher</code>	Serves the redirect on every front-office request.
<code>moduleRoutes</code>	The module's own routes.
<code>displayBackOfficeHeader</code>	Back-office styles and scripts.
<code>actionObjectProductUpdateBefore / ..After</code>	Captures the product slug before saving, compares it afterwards and creates the 301.
<code>actionObjectCategoryUpdateBefore / ..After</code>	The same for categories.

The data lives in three tables of its own: redirects, change history and detected suggestions.

9 Frequently asked questions

Does it replace the `.htaccess` rules?

For the store's redirects, yes: they are managed from the back office and are not lost when PrestaShop regenerates the file.

Does it measure the SEO effect of the redirects?

No. It creates and serves redirects; it does not store traffic or ranking metrics. That analysis belongs in Search Console or Analytics.

What about multistore?

The list, the export and the bulk delete work on the active store.

Why is my source URL rejected?

The source is always a relative path starting with `/`; the destination, an absolute URL with `http://` or `https://`.

10 License terms

Your purchase includes the Zeyvro Commercial License v1.0 ([LICENSE](#) file inside the package). Summary of its terms:

Scope	Non-exclusive, non-transferable, perpetual license for one (1) PrestaShop store in production, plus its associated staging and development environments. Each additional store needs its own license.
No DRM	The module ships with readable source code and no technical protection: no remote validation and no phone-home. It is a decision based on trust and is not a waiver of the license rights.
Allowed	Modifying the code to adapt it to your own store (internal use).
Not allowed	Reselling, sublicensing, redistributing or publishing the module or its code; using it on more stores than licensed; removing copyright notices.
Updates	Perpetual and at no extra cost for as long as Zeyvro maintains the product.
Support	6 months from the purchase date.
Warranty	Provided "as is"; Zeyvro's total liability is limited to the amount paid.
Refunds	Not accepted once downloaded, as this is digital content supplied immediately (art. 103.m of Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 1/2007), except for a defective module that cannot be fixed.
Governing law	Spanish law; courts of Barcelona unless mandatory rules provide otherwise.

Activation ≠ license

"Activation" is a technical mechanism to unlock software; this module does not use it. "License" is the contract that grants you the right to use it: it always exists, even when there is no key to enter.

11 Updates and support

- To update, upload the new ZIP from **Modules → Upload a module**: PrestaShop runs the upgrade and keeps your redirects.
- Do not uninstall the module to update it: uninstalling deletes its data.
- Since 1.7.1 the module invalidates its own files in OPcache when it is updated and warns you if your hosting does not allow it.
